



# DRIVER VISION

Drivers need to have full vision at all times



- ✔ Use sunblinds and tinted films on the rear and side windows to protect your child from glare, but make sure they still let in enough light.
- ✔ Keep shade hoods on car seats in the downward position to avoid blocking the driver's view and to help prevent the baby from getting too hot.
- ✔ Ensure sunblinds are securely fastened and won't distract you while driving.
- ✘ Don't use nappies or towels on side windows as they can block the driver's view.
- ✔ Place signs like "Baby on Board" where they won't obstruct your view.



# DRIVER DISTRACTION

Don't let your children's behaviour distract you



Keep them occupied by talking or singing to them and/or provide soft toys to play with.



Take regular breaks on long drives to allow everyone to stretch their legs.



Provide drinks that can't spill and healthy snack foods.
